Input: \$125,000 cash contributions.

Output: The advocacy efforts supported by Entergy grantee partners resulted in \$54 million in increased local, state and federal funds to expand access to high-quality childcare and early childhood education for low-income families. 1,400 additional families will be able to access subsidies for high-quality childcare. Additionally, 870 four-year-olds are being served through continued state funding for Preschool Expansion Grants. Increased city funding will enable 150 children and low-income families to access high-quality care plus wraparound services. Entergy grantee partners also supported the development of the LAB to 3 master plan, increasing access to early care and education.

Input: \$506,492

Output: \$155,250,000 in additional local, state and federal funding for early childhood education. An additional 33,2200 children from low-income families have access to high-quality early care and educations. As of April 2020, 20,514 children are being served through the childcare assistance program.

To ensure that all families, but particularly lowincome families, have access to high-quality, affordable childcare and education.

Input: \$270,000
